ROAR determines the criteria for fostering, decides which animals are eligible for foster care, and appoints foster caregivers from a pre-approved list of trained providers.

Please be advised you will be expected to keep the animal safe and secure, return it to ROAR when requested to do so, and not promise the animal to anyone, or imply that you have the authority to approve a potential adoption. ROAR retains ownership of all animals placed in foster care, and will make all decisions regarding the adoption and placement of the animals fostered.

ROAR cannot accommodate people fulfilling court-ordered community service within the foster care program. ROAR does not accept into this program those convicted of violent crimes or crimes involving animal cruelty or neglect. Students seeking credit for school service requirements should speak with a ROAR representative to discuss the program before proceeding.

Unless otherwise arranged, the foster parent is responsible for providing all food, litter, bedding, and toys for the animal while it is in their care at home. The foster parent is responsible for transporting the animals to and from veterinary appointments, surgery, behavior evaluations, vaccinations, etc. The foster parent may also be responsible for transporting the animal to and from adoption events and training classes, at ROAR's discretion. Upon return of your foster to ROAR, you will be required to fill out a brief questionnaire about your foster animal's behavior and needs.

I certify all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I understand that although ROAR takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster care placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the animals' health behavior, and actions. I understand that I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any animal for which ROAR has asked me to provide care. I acknowledge that ROAR is

not responsible for any property damage or personal injury suffered by me, members of my household, including my own animals, or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability to provide adequate controls to prevent such damage or injury.
